

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Registration for these enrichment opportunities is open September 1 - September 30.
- Final Zooms for discussion with other Presentation people are a part of each opportunity. A few also offer a Zoom at the start of the class. We hope you can join the Zoom conversation to engage in lively dialogue with other Presentation people. However, not being able to attend does not mean you cannot register for the opportunity.
- Even if you already know the content, engaging in one of these enrichment opportunities might refresh your memory, help you see something in a new way or allow you to meet other Presentation people. It is also a good way to get used to the software for future enrichment opportunities that might interest you.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- First, you must create an account. To do so, go to <https://formation.pbvmconference.org/login>.
 - If you need to create an account, click the button that says SIGN UP NOW (on the right).
 - After signing up your information will get sent in for approval. Once approved, you will receive an email with a temporary password.
 - Once you have this information, you can go back to the site and log in to see what classes are available for sign up by clicking on the VIEW COURSE CATALOG button.
- If you already have an account, enter the email used for the account and your password in the SIGN IN area (on the left).
 - If you are having trouble with your password, you can do a password reset.
 - If prompted to reset your password the "old password" is your current password or the temporary password you received. The "new password" is the new password you create for future use. This is required every so often for security purposes.
